

HSK Level-1(A) Course Introduction and Requirements

I. Course Overview

HSK Level-1(A) is a preparatory course for the HSK Level-1 Test, designed for beginners of Chinese. Through the systematic teaching arrangement, it helps students master basic Chinese knowledge in pronunciation, vocabulary, grammar and Chinese characters, improve simple listening, speaking, reading and writing skills, and lay a solid foundation for successfully passing the HSK Level 1 Test and obtaining the corresponding certificate.

II. Basic Course Arrangement

Course Duration and Frequency: The course lasts for 9 weeks, with 2 classes per week and each class lasting 2 hours. The specific class schedule will be announced in advance according to the teaching plan.

Class Size: The maximum class size for this course is set at 40 students.

III. Course Assessment and Passing Requirements

The composition of assessment scores and passing standards are as follows:

(I) Detailed Score Composition

Attendance (10%): The course will strictly record students' attendance. Students must make up for the missed course content by themselves.

Homework (30%): The homework will be checked and recorded at the beginning of each class.

Midterm Exam (20%): A midterm exam will be held after the 8th lesson.

Final Exam (40%): A final exam will be organized at the end of the course, which includes both oral and written parts.

Note: the proportion of the score may slightly variable according to the class teacher.

(II) Passing Standards and Certificate Acquisition

Students' final course scores are calculated by converting the four assessment items in proportion. A final score of 60 or above means passing the course. Students

who pass the course will receive the HSK Level-1(A) Course Completion Certificate.
